Additional Notes/Comments

The history involved an attempted robbery of a gym where the owner was assaulted on the first floor and later killed at the bottom of the basement steps. The assailant was caught and convicted. He had also been released recently. Reports include a shadow figure at the bottom of the stairs, a peaking face in the location of the old office and light flickering. EVP have also been recored during previous investigations from other groups. The first floor EMF readings were elevated between 1-3 mG. The readings in the kitchen area were 15-20 mG. The Pepsi refrig, at the top of the staircase was over 100 mG. Basement readings averaged between 5-6 mG. The electical panels, fire monitor, and numerous refrigerators created pockets of EM fieldstrength ranging from 20 mG - 100 mG. Extended periods of time in the basement will have an adverse effect on living tissue which may include nausea, tingling in hands and feet, muscle pain, head-aches, fatigue, and/or disorientation.

The light flickering was a result of the refrigeration and lighting on the same circuit. The lights flickered when the refrigeration units initiated.
